

Actress Kelly Preston Dies of Breast Cancer at 57

She privately fought the disease for two years.

On July 12, actress Kelly Preston, 57, died after a two-year battle with [breast cancer](#), reports [People](#). Preston's career spanned 40 years and included roles in films such as *Twins*, *Jerry Maguire* and *For the Love of the Game*.

"Choosing to keep her fight private, she had been undergoing medical treatment for some time, supported by her closest family and friends," said a family representative.

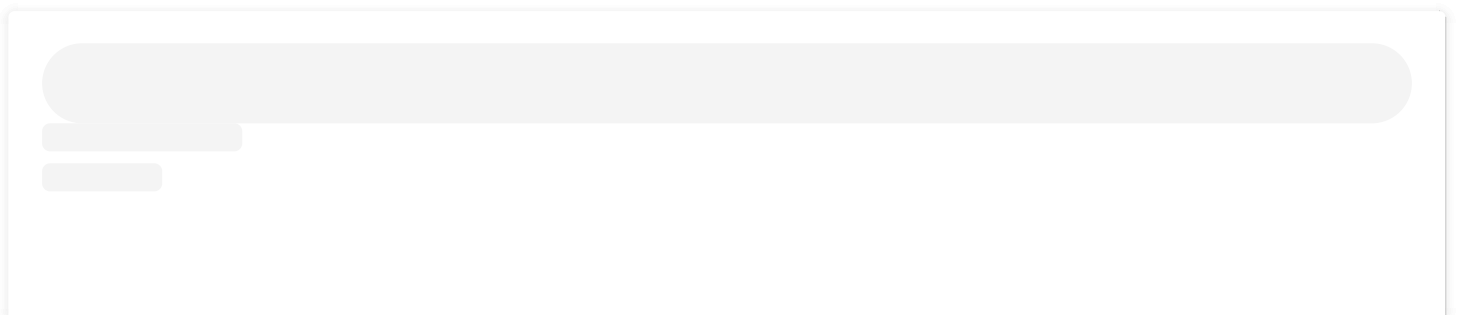
"She was a bright, beautiful and loving soul who cared deeply about others and who brought life to everything she touched. Her family asks for your understanding of their need for privacy at this time."

Preston was married to actor John Travolta, with whom she shared three children and collaborated on several films, including *The Experts*, *Battlefield Earth* and *Gotti*.

Travolta announced the death of his wife of 28 years on social media, saying that she fought courageously.

"My family and I will be forever grateful to her doctors and nurses at MD Anderson Cancer Center, all the medical centers that have helped, as well as her many friends and loved ones who have been by her side," he wrote on an Instagram post accompanying a picture of Preston. She reportedly had Stage IV [metastatic breast cancer](#).

Travolta wrote that Preston's love and life will always be remembered and that he would be taking time to provide emotional support to their children.
